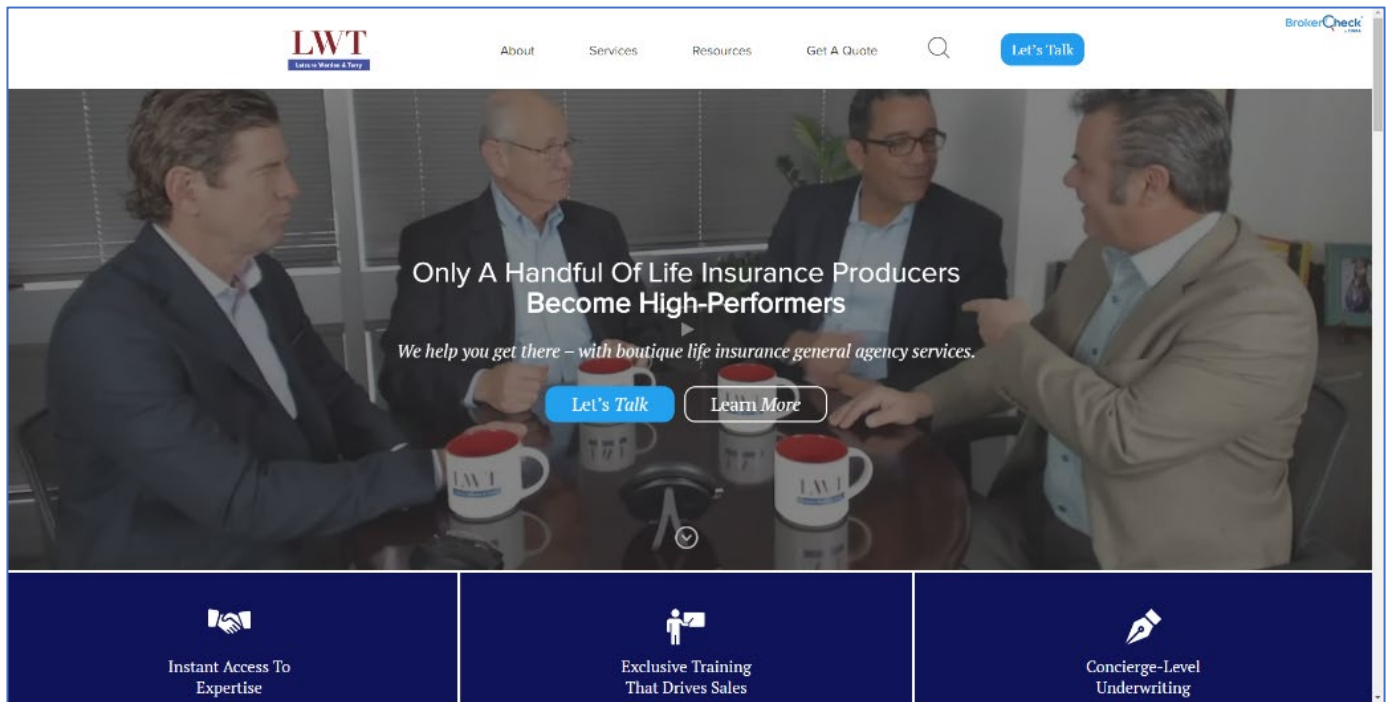
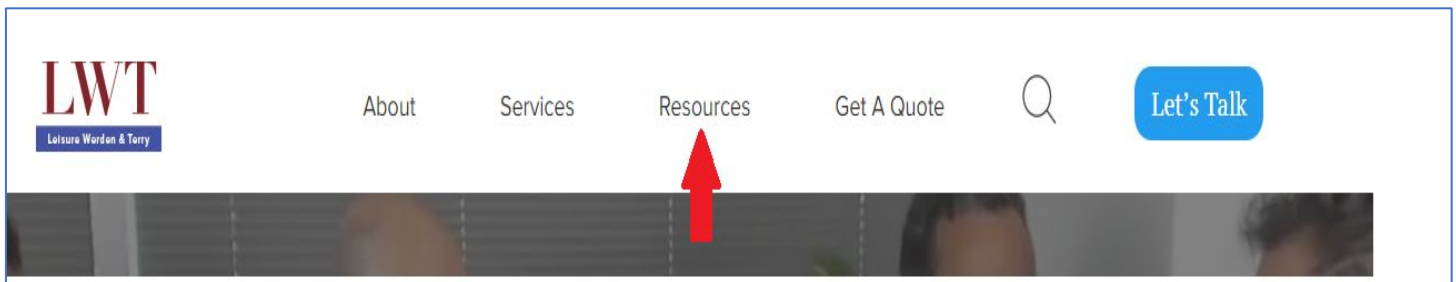


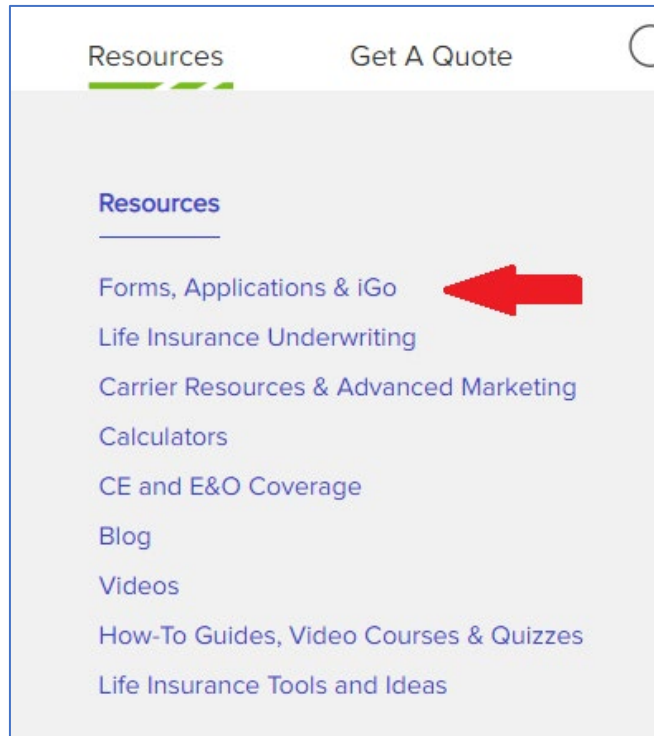
To access iGo, start at the LWT home page: [www.LWTagency.com](http://www.LWTagency.com)



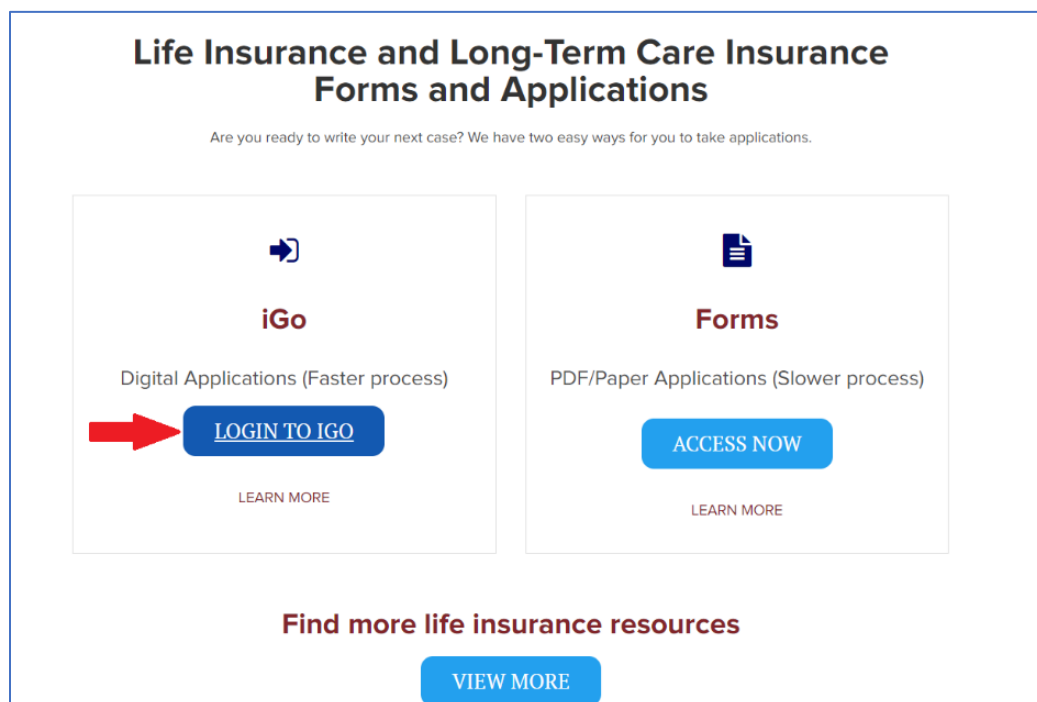
Next, hover your mouse over “Resources.”

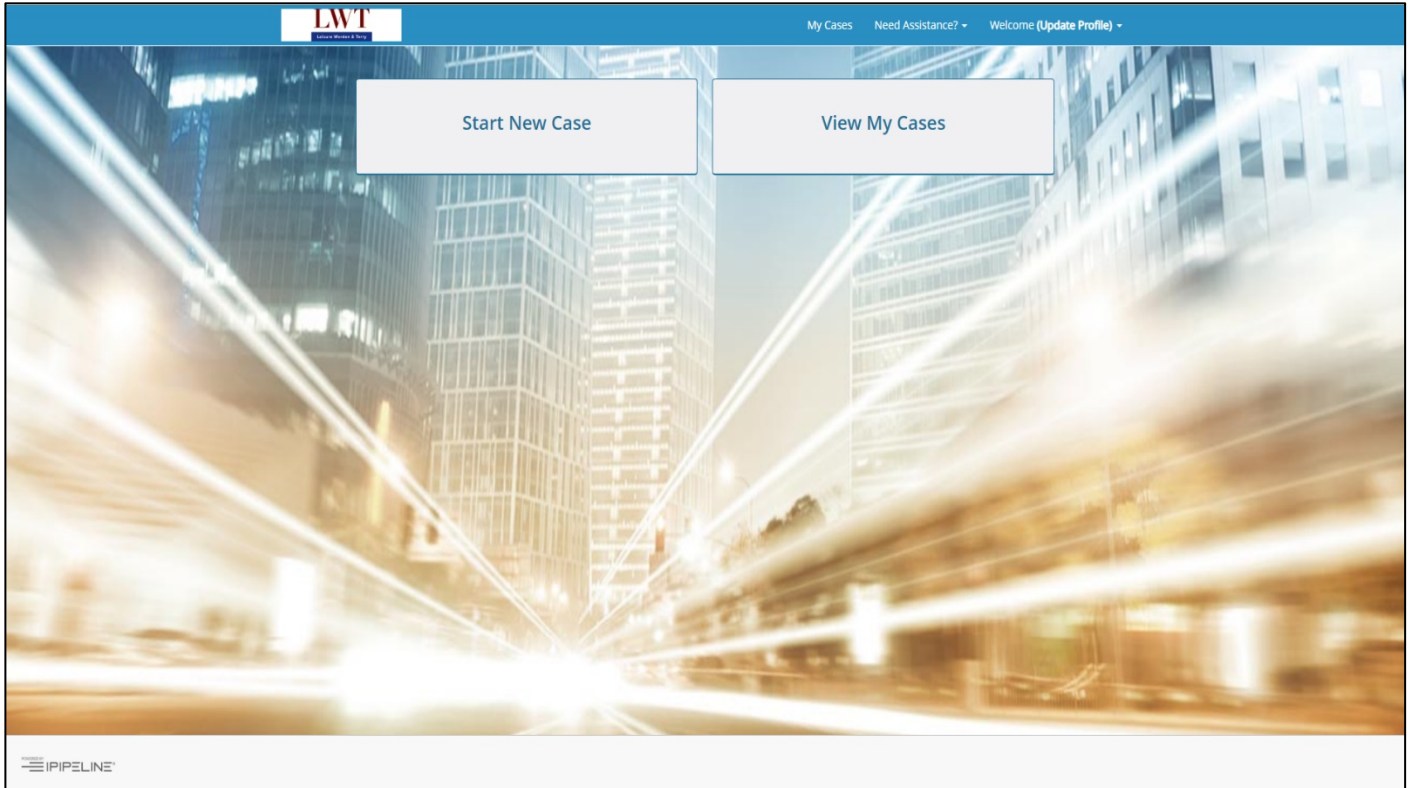
